SCRUTINY

In light of the weather forecast that has been given for the area and for the safety of you the competitors and your team members we have decided to relocate the scrutiny area to a warehouse which is located in Unit 1/2 Castlelands Business Park Newcastle West Co Limerick {Eircode V42 KF99} on Saturday from 16:00 to 19:00. As this there is 23km distance between the two locations **ALL CARS HAVE TO BE TRAILERED** from this location to the parc ferme / service area.

Due to the service area being used by factory staff, there is NO parking of any rally associated vehicles in the service park before 21:00 on Saturday night.

Mechanical scrutiny is by request only on Sunday morning, with prior arrangement with the Clerk of the Course and the chief scrutineer.

If this is your first event of 2020 please make yourself aware of the requirements for scrutiny as per 2020 year book.

The Service Park for the rally is located at Kostal in the Mountmahon Industrial Estate, Abbeyfeale.

On arrival in service area <u>ALL Rally Cars</u> must be unloaded and park trailers in designated trailer parking area. This will be sign posted and marshalled. Service area and trailer park map is available on club site and in the rally office. All Cars **MUST** be serviced on ground sheets. Secure parking in service on Saturday night will be provided.
